The people praising Jesus as he rode into Jerusalem on a donkey threw their cloaks on the ground before him and waved palm branches,

shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

Here's why this is amazing:


\* "Hosanna!" means "Save us!" It is also a word of praise.

\* The procession into Jerusalem is a dangerous political act

\* Riding a donkey is a sign of humility and peace.

Jesus is hailed as a prophet - one who fulfills what was foretold: "Tell the daughter of Zion, Look, your king is coming



"aood auvs" in power. As do we. Wouldn't we love a savior who would dislike the same people we dislike and always side with us and bring justice (as defined by us)? But that's not God's justice.

Jesus opens our eyes to God's justice – and when God's justice is seen through the eyes of Christ it leads to serving with the heart of Christ.

"This is my body, given for you. This is my blood, shed for you."

This month the gospel readings will place us in the palm procession, at the Last Supper, at the foot of the cross. And outside a tomb...

What do we think, feel, see, hear, smell and taste when we put ourselves in these places? What are we asking for when we shout "Hosanna! Save us!"? What do we experience in the bread and wine Jesus offers? What do we experience in the shadow of the cross? What do we experience outside that tomb, its stone door rolled aside?

When we shout "Hosanna!" on Palm/Passion Sunday (April 9), we do so with an understanding of the true salvation we have in Christ: that God's self-giving love overcomes all human division and pain, and we are called to live in and out of that love. So when we join with believers everywhere shouting "Hosanna! Save us!" we cry out for those who are hungry and thirsty and homeless and lonely and sick to be saved from their suffering. We cry out for ourselves to be saved from the greed, apathy and self-centeredness that cause us to turn a blind eye to the suffering around us. We cry out to be saved from all that separates us from God and from one another and from the wholeness God desires for all creation.

Please plan to participate in the special worship services that reveal the power of self-giving love: Maundy Thursday (April 13), which includes potluck dinner at 6:30 p.m. and worship at 7 p.m., both starting in the church hall; Good Friday (April 14) worship in the sanctuary at noon and at Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary with the joint-confirmation-program congregations at 7 p.m.; Easter Vigil (April 15) starting in the parking lot at 7 p.m.; and Easter Sunday (April 16) worship at 10 a.m. (pancake breakfast before).
