Interim pastor's December 2017 message

So often we hear: "At Advent we await the birth of the Christ Child." But Jesus was born 2,000 years ago! So is Advent an exercise in *re-enacting* awaiting the birth of Jesus? Or is it about anticipating Christ's return?

Meister Eckhart, 13th Century Christian mystic, said, "We are all meant to be mothers of God. For God is always needing to be born."

God is always needing to be born. The brilliant love and mercy of God incarnate every day shines through the darkness of suffering and injustice. Advent invites us into the spiritual practice of anticipating and pondering the



pregnant possibilities of each day. Advent opens us to see that Christ is always coming, always exhorting us, as we'll hear this month in Mark's gospel, to "stay awake." We'll also hear Isaiah's assurance that God turns our mourning into laughter, and we'll marvel at Mary's example of hope and faith.

This Advent season, let us be intentional in paying attention to what God is birthing in us and through us. Let us make time to contemplate and give thanks for the life-changing ramifications of Christ's mercy poured out today – even through the prayers, words and actions of ordinary believers like you and me.

Then all are welcome on Christmas Eve – that holy night when we offer candle-lit praise to *Emmanuel*, God-with-us. CLC's worship will begin at 5 p.m.; Mira Vista offers a 7:30 p.m. candlelight service. Invite someone to share the anticipated celebration!

DC in 2010. He is now a PhD candidate at the GTU, writing his dissertation on Christology in the age of religious pluralism, and is working to transfer his candidacy to the Sierra Pacific Synod. His wife and son are still in Norway. We welcome Daniel and are grateful that he will be among us sharing his many gifts.
